Could you help?

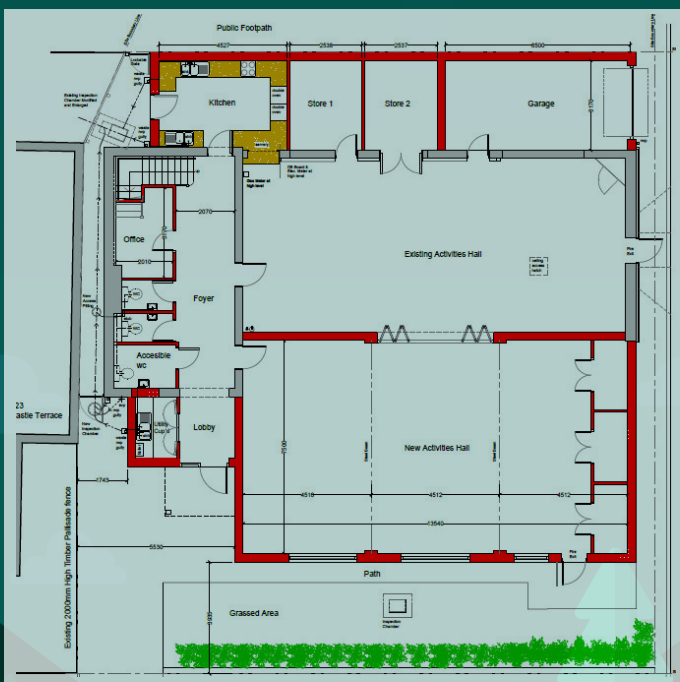

If you don't do this the DBS is cancelled.
